The Clarence Integrated Care Centre has come a long way in a very short time. Part of [Tasmania's Health Plan](#), the project is now moving into the design stage with community consultations well under way. This year the project reaches an exciting stage and will really start to take shape.

We have interviewed three architects who submitted proposals to design the new centre and expect to announce the successful applicant soon. The first phase of schematic design work should be completed by the end of March 2009. Project User Groups will be established to ensure service delivery input into the design of the new facility.

John Ramsay & Associates have begun work on the governance model for the Clarence ICC/GP Super Clinic. John has consulted with interested stakeholders and will continue this work in the New Year. A report with recommendations on the governance model should be completed by late February 2009.
